Spectrum Miami Contemporary Art Show Announces Event Schedule

-Spectrum Miami reveals 2015 event line up for an incredible 5-day fine art experience at its new location in the heart of Miami's Arts and Entertainment District-

MIAMI (Nov. 20, 2015) – [Spectrum Miami](#), a juried contemporary art show, taking place Dec. 2–6 at its new location in the heart of Miami's Arts and Entertainment District (NE 2nd Ave. at NE 17th St., Miami, FL 33132), announces its dynamic show schedule—a five-day fine art experience packed with cutting-edge exhibits, specially curated programming, and lively entertainment. Spectrum Miami will showcase innovative contemporary art from trendsetting artists and galleries with this year's theme, [EMERGENCE]—Innovative Vision Coming to Life.

On Opening Night, attendees will be the first to preview and purchase works. A percentage of all ticket sales benefit Life Is Art, a local Miami-based charity.
- **VIP EVENT: ART LOVES FASHION 6 p.m. – 9 p.m.**
Planet Fashion TV, the syndicated fashion series, will host "Art Loves Fashion," an invite-only event with fashion shows from Burberry Collection and LA Fashion Week's emerging design star. Watch the latest fashion trends come down the runway, enjoy specialty cocktails, and see a live performance by a special celebrity recording artist.
- **ART LAB 1—LIGHT THE NIGHT: UNVEILING 6 p.m. – 10 p.m.**
The work of video installation artists Tiffany Carbonneau and Brian Harper will illuminate the façade of Spectrum Miami, exploring the ways we are shaped by art that intervenes in our environment.
- **ART LAB 2—HELP HOPE NEPAL MURAL: UNVEILING 6 p.m. – 10 p.m.**
The Help Hope Nepal Mural is an incredible result of 400 artists from all over the world coming together to create a one-of-a-kind mural to benefit victims of the April 2015 Nepal earthquake. All of the proceeds will go to support the women and children affected by the earthquake through the Maiti Relief Fund.
- **MEET THE ARTIST ART DEMONSTRATION: STICK TOGETHER 7 p.m.**
Watch as tape artist Max Zorn creates a magical "Stick Together" masterpiece out of ordinary brown packing tape and a scalpel. Zorn shapes layer upon layer of tape on acrylic glass that, when illuminated from behind, reveals a contrast and depth from sepia-toned creations, straight lines, and sharp subjects.

Inspired by Spectrum Miami's [EMERGENCE] theme, the artists will offer a glimpse into how each piece of art uniquely emerges, giving light to the artist's creativity and medium.

Michael Alfano will showcase his participatory sculpture *Cubed* at the entrance of Spectrum Miami. *Cubed* depicts a face that's ten times larger than life-size, and divided into nine moveable pieces, each pigmented in a different skin tone. *Cubed* depicts a realistic male image on one side and an inverted female on the other, challenging definitions of gender and race. Visitors can rework a small-scale version at Alfano's booth (S1111), which will then be rearranged and reflected on the large-scale *Cubed* throughout the day.

Spectrum Miami will present Philip Noyed's "Rainbow Pyramid Light Experience" alongside Tiffany Carbonneau and Brian Harper's façade illumination. Noyed's immersive installation is an orchestration of a series of distinct colors changing in time.
