

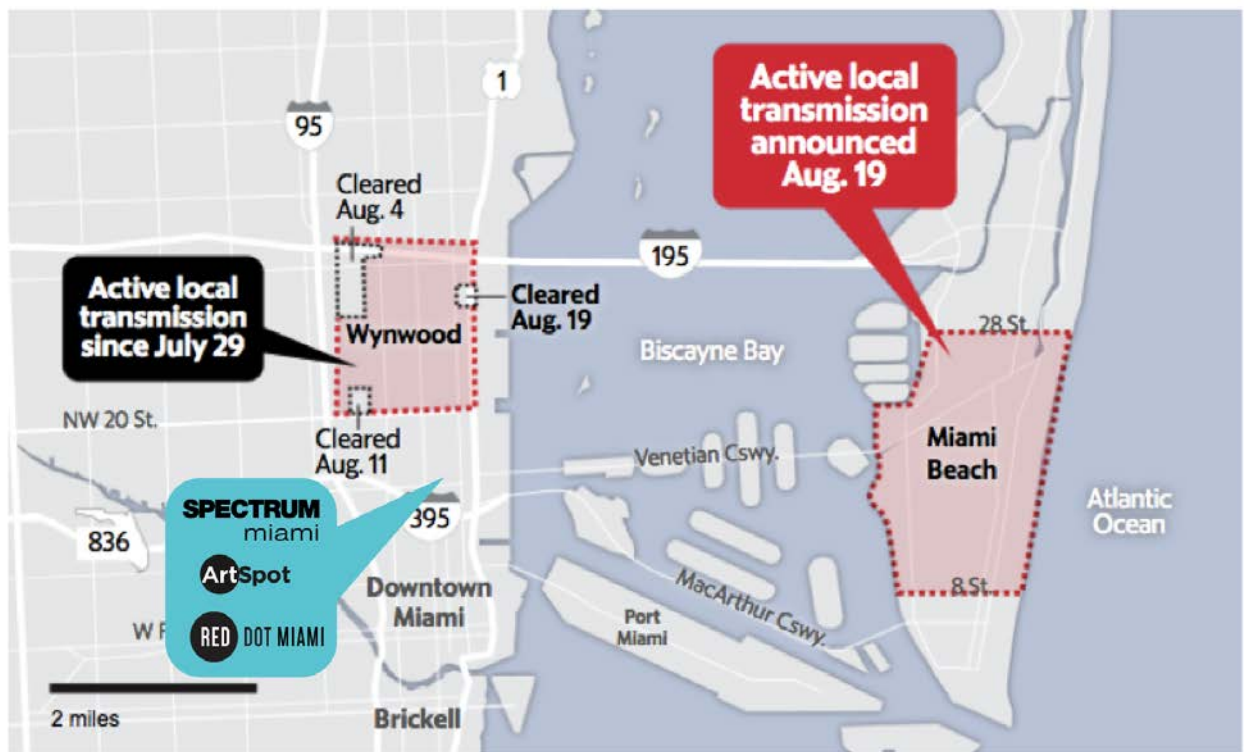


As you may have seen in the news, certain areas of Miami have been identified as having active cases of Zika. The two areas affected are Wynwood (one-square-mile area) and Miami Beach (1.5-square-mile zone)—Spectrum Miami and Red Dot Miami are located in the Arts & Entertainment District (please see the map below).

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Florida and Miami-Dade County are taking appropriate steps to control mosquitoes and protect pregnant women—and we will do the same by passing out repellents at the show.
